

Bank, fitness center to locate at Routes 47, 126

Crews are working on a bank and a fitness center to be located in a strip center on the north west corner of Routes 47 and 126 in Yorkville.

State Bank of Illinois president Rick Worzala said that he is hoping to have a temporary facility operating by March 1. Around the same time construction is supposed to start on a free standing bank off of the intersection.

HRM properties representative Mason Oliver said that the 16,000 square foot mall is entering its next phase of building.

"We are just finishing the shell of the building and getting ready to do two

build outs - the bank and Anytime Fitness Center."

"We are getting ready to close on the property for the actual bank site on the corner but they're going to do a build-out in the shopping center to be open earlier, Olivier said."

As for the fitness center, Lynn Dubajic, executive director for the Yorkville Economic Development Corporation, said that Anytime Fitness Center will provide resident with a round the clock opportunity to work out.

"Anytime Fitness is like a 24 hour fitness center where you have an electronic card to access the facility but you can literally work out any day of the year 365 days a year 24 hours a day,"
